Frequently Asked Questions!

'Am I eligible for the service?'

Yes - If you are registered with one of the GPs taking part in this service, and if you are suffering from one of the conditions listed on the left.

'Can I go to any pharmacy?'

Not all pharmacies are providing this service, please see the list. Over time, more pharmacies will join the service. You can also phone NHS Direct on 0845 4647 for details of the nearest pharmacy to you.

'What do I have to do next?'

You can go straight to one of the pharmacies providing the service. You do not need an appointment. Show the staff the leaflet, or just ask for the 'Pharmacy First' service.

The pharmacy staff **MUST** see the person who needs help. You **MUST** take the patient to the pharmacy if it is your child/partner etc.

'What questions will I be asked?'

You will be asked about your symptoms. This will include details of other medicines you are taking and other illnesses you might have. They will ask this to make sure that you get the right medicine for your particular situation.

'Will I always get a medicine?'

No, not necessarily. Sometimes the pharmacy staff will decide that the best treatment involves a home remedy, or just letting the illness take its course. This is a scheme to treat minor problems in the best possible way.

'Will a record be kept of my treatment?'

Yes - the pharmacist will make a record on the computer each time you use this service. All details will be kept confidential, as explained on the consultation audit form. It is important for the pharmacy and the PCT to be able to see how people use 'Pharmacy First' so that we can give the best possible service. From time to time you may be asked for your opinions about the service.

'Will any checks be made?'

If you do not pay for prescriptions, we will ask for proof in the usual way and ask you to sign a form. If you do pay prescription charges, and a medicine is recommended, then you will have to pay the charge or the cost of the medicine, whichever is cheaper.

Important

Your community pharmacy is providing treatment and/or advice under the 'Pharmacy First' service in line with your presenting symptoms.

If your symptoms persist, you should seek advice from your GP. Take this leaflet to your Doctor so that he/she knows which pharmacy you have attended.
